

Falmouth High Application Virtualization

FHS Virtualization is a way to give secure access to users the technology resources available at Falmouth High School almost anywhere you have access to a web browser using Citrix Virtualization services. Currently we have made available Microsoft Office, Adobe PhotoShop, Adobe Dreamweaver and Adobe Acrobat/Distiller. There is secure access to your data on the server (Z: drive) .

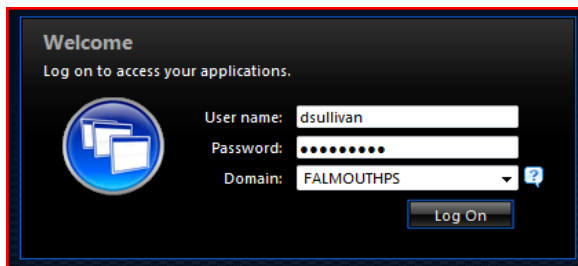
How to access

We have two ways of accessing the Citrix server:

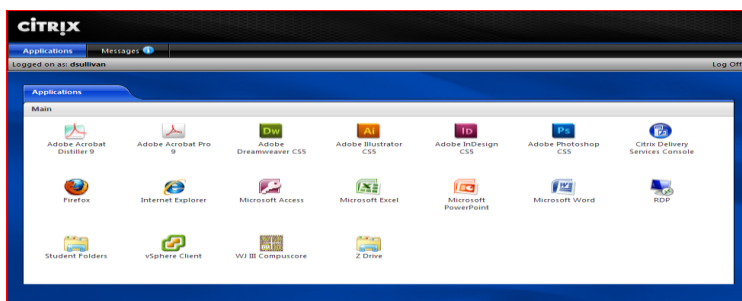
- 1) From within FHS <https://172.31.11.56> or <https://CTXWEB1>

To log in you need to enter the same credential you would use to log on to a computer at FHS.

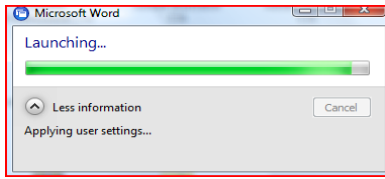


The first time you log in you will likely see a message that you are required to download and install a client. Mark the checkbox and click Download and select Run when prompted. Follow any of the Defaults Selections in the dialogue boxes that come up. When everything is completed, you will see the Citrix Desktop and what applications you have access to use.



Launching Applications

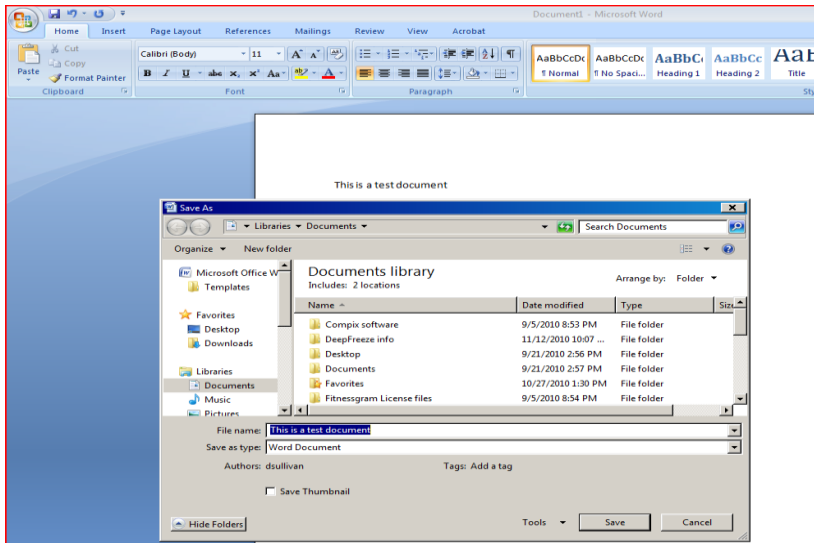
To launch an application, just double click on it. It will open up a Citrix session for that application, normally in the background.



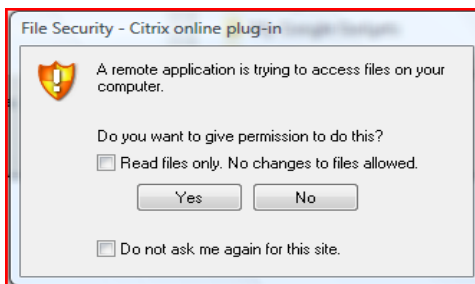
When the application is ready, the window opens just as if it was running on your computer.

Accessing/Saving/Printing Documents

Your default opening and saving of files will be to your Documents folder (Your Z drive on the server). You can access data on your local computer by browsing from within the dialogue box.



You may be prompted for local access to your drive to open or save locally.



To open a local file on your computer you will need to navigate to your C: drive and Users (Vista and Windows 7) or Documents and Settings (Windows XP and older).

Any printing will be to the printer connected to the computer you are using.
