TIPS ON APPLYING FOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS



- * **READ** the qualifying requirements of each scholarship to determine your eligibility.
- * Carefully attend to completing the application.
- * Follow the **DEADLINE DATES**.
- * It is your responsibility to obtain all letters of reference and/or related supporting credentials which need to be included with the application.
- * Transcripts will be provided by Guidance Dept.
- * Be prepared to estimate the college expenses for the school year 2018-2019.



Billable Costs:

These are fixed costs that the family is billed for by the college - such as tuition and fees, and room and board.

Indirect Costs:

These are the costs that don't show up on the college bill. They include books, supplies and travel, as well as personal expenses such as laundry, telephone and pizza. If you live and dine off campus, room and board costs will also be indirect costs. You can control indirect costs to some degree, by making smart spending choices.

College Expense - Break Down

Tuition and Fees:

Cost of education, may vary on Academic Program.

Room and Board:

Charges will vary depending on room and meal plan chosen.

Books and Supplies:

Covers books and course materials. Estimate \$1,200.

Personal Expenses:

This covers the cost of laundry, telephone. Estimate \$2,000.

Travel:

car, plane, train
